

### 13. Club Branch –

Clubs may form branches to permit the expansion of Lionism into locations where and when circumstances do not support the formation of a charter club. The branch would meet as a subsidiary with a branch president, secretary and treasurer serving as elected officers. These three individuals, along with the branch liaison, make up the executive committee of the branch.

The names of a minimum of five branch members are required to form a club branch.

International, Multiple District and District dues are collected and paid by the parent club. Members are added, deleted and recorded on the Monthly Membership Report of the parent club.

The parent club must notify the district governor of the formation of the proposed branch.

When a club branch is converting to a newly chartered club, the branch members shall be dropped from the parent club per completion of the Club Branch Conversion Form, affixed with the signatures of the parent club secretary and district governor.
