 - Review** the Leo annual report created by the Leo chairperson on status of Leo clubs
 - Meet** with Leo district officers and/or Leo club presidents to establish district schedule for Leos service and convention
- Q2**
- Promote** reporting of Leos in MyLCI to Lions with Leo clubs to show the future of Lions in your district
 - Encourage** Lions without Leo clubs to work with their chairperson to identify fit for Leo club advisor and steps to [start their own Leo club](#)
 - Train** Leo Club Advisors through District Leo Chairperson led seminars and workshops
 - Send** a celebratory message to Leos in your district on International Leo Day, December 5
- Q3**
- Collaborate** with Leos on implementing one district-wide Leo and Lion joint service project utilizing a LCIF Leo Service Grant
 - Appoint** Leos to serve with Lions on District Convention planning boards
 - Share** success stories of Leos to Lions in your District
- Q4**
- Extend** invitation to all Leos to the District Lion Conventions
 - Invite** graduating Leos to transition to a Lions club through Leo-Lion membership
 - Celebrate** Leos for their service through awards and recognition
 - Encourage** active Leos to apply for the International Leo Advisory Panel
